COMPETITION RULES ALPE ADRIA 3D CUP Proposal by Slovenia, Croatia and Italy 5.3.2012

1. GENERAL

1. Austria, Italy¹, Slovenia and Croatia established new 3D archery competition – ALPE ADRIA 3D CUP – AA3DC.
2. Four international AA3DC events, one in each country, will be organized in a calendar year, following WA Rules for 3D Archery.
3. Every nation will take part in at least three events each year.
4. The finals round is organized at the end of the last tournament of the season and is hosted by different country every year in a cyclic fashion.
5. Other WA members are allowed to take part in the event, however they can not be classified for the AA3DC trophies, money prizes and final AA3DC result list.

2. CATEGORIES

1. Each category is combined from juniors, seniors and masters:
 - Longbow women according to WA regulations
 - Longbow men according to WA regulations
 - Instinctive Bow women according to WA regulations
 - Instinctive Bow men according to WA regulations
 - Barebow women according to WA regulations
 - Barebow men according to WA regulations
 - Compound women according to WA regulations
 - Compound men according to WA regulations
2. All restrictions of the characteristics, equipment and power of the bows are the same as described by WA 3D regulations.
3. The finals for money prizes are organized in combined categories: LB, IB+BB and CU separated by genders.

4. CLASSIFICATION

1. To be included in the final classification of the AA3DC each athlete has to participate in at least three AA3DC events of which the last (final) event is mandatory.
2. Scoring for each AA3DC cup tournament:

1 st place - 20 points	7 th place - 4 points
2 nd place - 15 points	8 th place - 3 points
3 rd place - 10 points	9 th place - 2 points
4 th place - 7 points	10 th place - 1 point
5 th place - 6 points	
6 th place - 5 points	Other places do not count
3. In case of equal total scoring points, higher rank goes to the competitor with better result in the last tournament.
4. Four competitors of both genders and combined categories: LB, IB+BB, CO with best total scoring points enter the prize money finals round on the last tournament. If more than four athletes qualify for the finals round, the shoot off will be organized.

5. INDIVIDUAL FINALS ROUND

1. Finals round is organized on 4+4 targets according to following rules:

SEMIFINALS on targets 1-4

LB MEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 1, pair 2:3 assigned on target 2
LB WOMEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 3, pair 2:3 assigned on target 4
IB+BB MEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 1, pair 2:3 assigned on target 2
IB+BB WOMEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 3, pair 2:3 assigned on target 4
CO MEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 1, pair 2:3 assigned on target 2
CO WOMEN	pair 1:4 assigned on target 3, pair 2:3 assigned on target 4

accompanied by referee and recording clerk
shooting 4 targets in rotation, assessed by referee, recorded by recording clerk
regroupation follows – losers shooting for bronze on targets 5-8, winners wait for the gold medal match

BRONZE MEDAL MATCH on targets 5-8

LB MEN	assigned on target 5
LB WOMEN	assigned on target 7
IB+BB MEN	assigned on target 5
IB+BB WOMEN	assigned on target 7
CO MEN	assigned on target 5
CO WOMEN	assigned on target 7

accompanied by referee and recording clerk
shooting 4 targets in rotation, assessed by referee, recorded by recording clerk

GOLD MEDAL MATCH on targets 1-4

LB MEN	assigned on target 1 and 2
LB WOMEN	assigned on target 3 and 4
LB+BB MEN	assigned on target 1 and 2
LB+BB WOMEN	assigned on target 3 and 4
CO MEN	assigned on target 1 and 2
CO WOMEN	assigned on target 3 and 4

accompanied by referee and recording clerk
shooting 4 targets on rotation, assessed by referee, recorded by recording clerk

2. There must be at least two competitors in each category in the finals. The winner of the finals becomes the winner of the AA3DC money prize.

6. ENTRY FEES

1. Entry fee for each competition is 15€ and does not include meal.
2. If organizer offers meal, it can be charged up to 5€ and this need to be clearly stated in the invitation. In this case meal can be ordered when enrolling for the tournament.



6. MEDALS, TROPHIES AND MONEY PRIZES

1. The first 3 ranked athletes in each category will be awarded with medals in each of the 4 events.
2. On the last tournament, trophies and money prizes for AA3DC are granted.
3. Trophies for the AA3DC are provided by organizer of the tournament.
4. The winner in each category will be awarded with trophy.
5. Money prizes are reimbursement of entry fees from funds of all the organizers and archery federations.
6. The total prize fund is 2.400 €.
7. Each tournament organizer contributes 200€.
8. Each archery federation contributes 400€.
9. If archery federation does not pay its contribution, the organizing club with its sponsors is responsible for the contribution.
10. Money prizes of AA3DC goes to first three ranked athletes in each combined category: LB, IB+BB, CO.
 - first ranked in finals 250€
 - second ranked in finals 100€
 - third ranked in finals 50€

7. FINAL PROVISIONS

1. AA3DC results will be published on the web site of the archery federation from organizing country. Each organizer of the event will take care of that. The organizer of the final event needs to follow the results of all previous events by himself and is responsible for the calculation of final results.
2. Regulations are valid from the day of confirmation of all 4 nations.
